Geography

A period of artistic flowering among African-American writers and artists that was centered in Harlem during the 1920s

The first African American to win a Pulitzer Prize

The first African American to be named a permanent member of the Metropolitan Opera Company, as well as the first to perform at the White House.

The founder and artistic director of Dallas Black Dance Theatre.
